

#### 1. Date

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Tenniquoits World Championships 2010 take place from July 31<sup>st</sup> at 11:00 am (Opening ceremony) to August, 6<sup>th</sup> till 9:00 pm (Closing ceremony).

# 2. Place

# 3. Competitions

The following competitions are scheduled:

I. World Championships Men & Women – Singles

II. World Championships Team

III. Exhibition Championships Men & Women – Doubles

IV. Exhibition Championships Mixed – Doubles

V. Exhibition Championships Men & Women – Doubles Free Style

Competitions I, II, III and IV must be played according to WTF-Rules. Competition V has to be played according to WTF-Rules with one exception: Players are not obliged to play alternating.

Competition I and II are official World Championships disciplines. Competition III and IV are no official World Championships, but have the character of an unofficial World Championships. Competition V has the character of an International German Masters.

# 4. Contingents

Each delegation is allowed to send 15 persons to participate at the  $2^{nd}$  Tenniquoits World Championships.

The delegation is allowed to contain up to 6 men – players at most and up to 6 women – players at most. Each delegation is allowed to send 1 manager, 1 coach and 1 referee.

Each delegation is allowed to register up to 4 women – players and 4 men – players for competition I.

Each delegation is allowed to participate at competition II. Therefore each team must contain 5 men – players and 5 women – players.

Each delegation is allowed to register 3 men - doubles and 3 women - doubles to participate at competition III.

Each delegation is allowed to register  $3 \, \text{mixed} - \text{doubles}$  to participate at competition IV. Each delegation is allowed to register  $3 \, \text{men}$  - doubles and  $3 \, \text{women} - \text{doubles}$  to participate at competition V.

All delegation members have to be announced with the attached list with their full name, gender and age towards the Secretary General of the World Tenniquoits Federation till deadline May, 31<sup>st</sup>. Players of the Men & Women – Singles and the Men & Women – Doubles have to be announced with the attached entry lists with their full name till deadline May, 31<sup>st</sup>. Entries for all

other competitions will be made on-site, but at least one day before the specific competition starts. Complete delegations are obliged to participate at the World Championships for Teams.

# 5. Officials of the WTF

Official office-bearer of the WTF (President, Executive Vice-President, Secretary General and Regional Vice-Presidents), who are not player, coach, manager or referee of the delegation are invited to join the 2<sup>nd</sup> World Championships 2010 in Koblenz additionally. In this case officials of the WTF are not counted as members of the delegation but as representatives of the WTF. Office-bearer of the WTF have to be announced by the attached list for officials separately. Items 6 to 13 are obliging for officials the same. All officials of the WTF are called on to take part at the General Meeting in Koblenz, which is held during the World Championships.

# 6. Arrival and check-in date of accommodation

Shuttle bus will pick up delegations at central station of Koblenz at July, 30<sup>th</sup> (check-in date of accommodation) and transfer delegations to the place of their common accommodation. Each delegation has to manage its journey to central station of Koblenz for own account and right in time. Arrival time at Koblenz or delays could be announced to Mr. Gunthard Kissinger by phone (+49-261-210834) or mobile (+49-171-4175276).

Those delegations, which arrive earlier than July, 30<sup>th</sup> in Germany, should organize their stay before the check-in day of accommodation for own account. Local organizer will support and recommend hotels or submit hotel lists on request.

### 7. Transfers

Shuttle transfers by bus in and around Koblenz during the World Championships will be arranged by the local organizer.

# 8. Accommodation

Accommodation is guaranteed from July, 30<sup>th</sup> to August, 7<sup>th</sup>. That means one day before the starting day to one day after the closing day of the World Championships.

The rooms are mainly 1-person and 2-person rooms.

# 9. Meals

Three meals per day (breakfast, lunch and diner) are provided from July, 31<sup>st</sup> to August, 6<sup>th</sup>. A breakfast will be provided at the day of the departure (August, 7<sup>th</sup>).

# 10. Departure and check-out date of accommodation

Shuttle bus will bring delegations to central station of Koblenz at August, 7<sup>th</sup> (check-out date of accommodation). Each delegation has to manage its journey from central station of Koblenz to airport and back home for own account and right in time.

Those delegations, which stay longer than August, 7<sup>th</sup> in Germany, should organize their stay after the check-out day of accommodation for own account. Local organizer will support and recommend hotels or submit hotel lists on request.

## 11. Fee for accomodation and meals

Each participating federation has to pay the amount of 150 Euro per each person of the delegation.

This fee quarantees free accommodation and meals in Koblenz from July 30<sup>th</sup> to August, 7<sup>th</sup> as stated at items 8 and 9.

The total amount has to be paid till June, 15<sup>th</sup> to the above stated account.

Example: A federation sending a full delegation of 15 persons has to pay the total amount of 2.250 Euro (=15 x 150 Euro).

The World Tenniquoits Federation will transfer the received fee of the participating federations to the account of the local organizer.

### 12. Reimbursement of fees

The fee, demanded by the local organizer for accommodation and meals, has been reduced by finding sponsors for the World Championships from 300 to 150 Euro per each participating person.

We furthermore permanently try to find more sponsors till end of July. In case we will find more sponsors to reduce further parts of your fees a potential reimbursement to you then will be repaid during the Championships on site in Koblenz.

## 13. Deadlines

The payment of the fees has to be received at the above stated account (see item 11) till June, 15<sup>th</sup> 2010.
